Democracy

Our school ethos is based on RRR model and all children contribute to drawing up class charters. We listen to both pupil and parent voice. All children are part of the School Councils and elect representatives from their class to the meetings. Pupil voice is heard through P4C and is seen through Peer Mentors, Library monitors, School Councillors and Ambassadors.

Tolerance

As Totton is not an area that is very culturally diverse we aim to enhance children's understanding of different faiths and beliefs by raising awareness of a range of celebrations throughout the year. We promote diversity through celebrations of different faiths and cultures. Religious Education, Assemblies, PSHE and P4C have specific activities which reinforce messages of tolerance and respect for others.

Liberty

We actively encourage the children to make good choices, knowing that they are in a safe and secure environment. Our teaching and learning policies consist of learning behaviours based on resilience, relationships, resourcefulness, respect and reflectiveness.

Rule of Law

We constantly reinforce our high expectations of the children. Children are taught the behaviour expectations of the school. Children are taught the values and reasons behind these expectations and their responsibilities. They are taught the reason and values behind the laws in this country, how they protect us and what happens when they are broken.

Respect

Children learn that their behaviours have an effect on their own rights and those of others. All members of the school community treat each other with respect. Children know what bullying is and what to do if they are being bullied or are a bystander to bullying. As well as supporting national initiatives (e.g Children in Need, Comic relief, Poppy Appeal). The children support other local community causes such as The Big Tidy.
