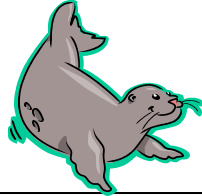




# Key stage 1 Summer 1



## Literacy

After reading Uno's Garden, the children will write commands telling people how to look after our planet. We will write non fiction reports about recycling and saving the bee population. We will also write animal riddles and poems about our wonderful world.

## Science

In science we are going to explore plants, which will include looking at their features. We are also going to think about insects including learning about their anatomy. We will investigate how we can help insect populations in our school grounds.

## Numeracy

We will learn about 2D and 3D shape as well as rotation, quarter and half turns, position and direction. We will be solving problems using all four operations. We will learn about measures, including capacity.

## Hook and round up.

Rationale: The children will listen to the book Uno's Garden. Mr McElhenny will show a video which looks around the community and finding quite a few problems. The children will become eco warriors. How will they tell people how to look after our environment?

Round up: We will create a junk model sculpture by re-using different items. Please keep cardboard, milk bottles or anything else that could be used. This will be a virtual round-up and the children will bring their sculpture home.

## Geography

We are going to identify the four countries of the United Kingdom. We are then going to compare England to Malaysia. We will find out why their weather is different to ours.
