

Key stage 1 Spring





Literacy

We are going to read and learn the story 'Blue Penguin'. We will describe the world the penguin lives in and recount his trip. We will write our own stories based on animals who are similar, but look different. We will write information booklets about penguins and the world they live in.

Science

We are going to look at arctic food chains. We will think about how animals are adapted to help them survive in cold climates. The children will conduct science experiments around keeping things hot or cold. We will see how temperature changes different materials, such as ice.

Maths

In maths we will practising our number bonds and solvina problems involvina addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also learn about telling the time and mass or weight.





To **hook** the children into our frozen planet topic we will come into school to find that our classrooms have become an Arctic wonderland. How does it feel to be in the Arctic? What would we see and
