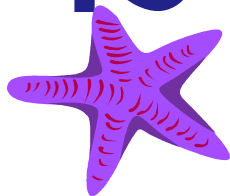




Topic Title: It's an emergency!

Hook: A letter from Rapunzel asking for help

Communication, Language and Literacy
Stories: Rapunzel, Cinderella, Meg and the Vet, Three Little Pigs, Iggy Peck Architect, Ada Twist Scientist, Hansel and Gretel
Write own name. Write labels. Identify initial sounds. Begin to read and write CVC words.
Retell stories orally.
Read some common high frequency words.
Recite rhymes and continue a rhyming string.



Physical
Develop awareness of space. Move in different ways; following instructions.
Develop control in jumping, balancing, throwing, catching, pushing, pulling and kicking.
Develop good pencil control and begin to form letters correctly.

Knowledge of the World
Finding out about other people's traditions and customs – bonfire night, Christmas.
Exploring different materials.
Finding out about different occupations.
Using Ipads and controlling remote control toys.

Mathematical
Continue to count carefully.
Combine sets to find how many altogether.
Find 1 more and 1 less using numbers to 10.
Describe patterns.
Use directional language.



How you can help

- Read lots of stories to your child
- Share your child's school reading book with them every day and practice the key words
- Help your child to practice writing their name
- Help your child to consolidate their phonic knowledge – reading and spelling simple words

Reminders
